

# Newlyn Archive Open Day

**Saturday March 23, 2019 10.00-3.00**

This Open Day explores the history of the area of Newlyn Town South that stretches in an almost straight line from the *Balcony* (once the Navy Inn where the press gangs worked), past Upper and Lower Green Street, to *Green Slip* that led to the boathouses that later became *Hosking's Sail Loft*. In 1884 the *South Pier* was built, and later it was extended and there were two *light houses* and the world famous *Tidal Observatory*. Now an artist occupies the Hosking properties and below him is *Harvey's Crab Tanks*, but the second light house and the tidal observatory are still there and were *listed* in 2018 as part of our Cornish Heritage.
